

# Waxing Buddha's Full Moon – Inviting the Desirable

The Buddha's Full Moon will be exact on Wednesday, May 10th at 5:42pm east coast time.

For us in the North, we have Halloween and Candlemas and Beltane (all around now and the Full Moon) and Lammas. So it's the Halloween of Spring (still - it's all around mid season-ish, and this Full Moon really activates it). And for those in the Southern Hemisphere, let's think of it as the fecund aspect of dark mystery. But it is incarnational invitational cahooting time!}
